Mounted right above or below the TV screen, as close to the same height of the Left and Right speakers as possible

Rear Surround Sound Speakers:

Mounted 2'-3' above ear level on the side or rear walls, ceiling mounted and just behind the listening area. Surround speakers should be matched in quality to the front speakers.

____ In-Wall ____ Wall Mount ____ Bookshelf ____ Column Other _____

Sub-Woofer:

A stand alone powered sub-woofer is recommended for the optimum results. It should be located in a corner that is furthest from any doorways or windows with an AC outlet nearby. A passive In-Wall or In-Floor sub-woofer can be used if all speakers are flush mounted.
